Cottle for his claim for military service performed by his brother Jediah Cottle - for answer you say you (illegible word) that if year inconsistent on the application to prove that Judigah was enlisted giving the year and that he served to the end of the same & all which has been done twice and more(?) for he proved himself to be heir at law of the said Jedijah as he was the only full brother - all the necessary papers was first put into the hand of General Moore by me Col. Buford's certificate of Judjah being enlisted being the (illegible) and of his being killed at his defeat. Mr. Moore will inform you that this is the case but he mislaid them. I got the necessary proofs a second time together with Mr. Moore's affidavit that he had the above papers (illegible) and Col. Buford's 2nd certificate all which I put in the hand of Mr. Wilson(?) and he told me that he had made application and that he had the business completely done and had a proper entry made at the proper place and that there was nothing waiting(?) but (several illegible). It appears that Judiah Cottle was killed that day (illegible) Masrch from the time that he inlisted during the war but he had been some time in the service before - It was before that this read(?) one years pay coming to J. Cottle when he was killed which William Cottle explained to (illegible) but that will merit proof (illegible) just inform that the people here generally are often (much of the rest illegible including the signature).

ps. I think Mr Wilson could not be mistaken about Mr Cottle's claim if you will be so good as to Enq(uire) of some others at the Clerk's perhaps we will find the entry drawn(?) for that purpose.

History of Nicholas Co by William Griffee Brown:

p. 16 - " Cottle Knob was named for C. W. Cottle, a man prominent in the settlement of the county. He had a cattle farm in the glades near by."

p 33 - " C. W. Cottle had come to Strouds Glades at an early date. The natural meadows furnished abundant pasturage and hay for his stock, and he became the first successful cattleman in the county. The Glades were soon known as Cottle Glades and the high hill to the west became Cottle Knob. He was an energetic business man, widely and favorably known, and

was Sheriff of Kanawha County a short time before Nicholas County was organized."

p 34 - " In 1814 the population of Kanawha County was about five thousand. The law of Virginia provided that a new County must have a population of one thousand or more. In 1815 a committee consisting of C. W. Cottle, Samuel Neil, Edward Ryan, and others, had drafted a rough outline of a new County, containing the requisite population.

p 46-47 - from the memoirs of Colonel Edward Campbell published in 1883: "The organization was on the second Tuesday in April, 1818 and according to an act of the Virginia Legislature. ...Esq. (Samuel) Neil administered the oath of office to his associates, to-wit: ... C. W. Cottle..." The following day there was an election held for two delegates to the General Assembly. E. Rian and C. W. Cottle were found to be elected.

p 48 - When on April 8th the question came up for adjournment to the May Term, Justices (8 of them) voted to meet at the Hamilton residence. The other justices (8 including C. W. Cottle) voted to meet at "our county seat" on the Archibald Hutchison farm. It was a complete deadlock.

p 51 - "At the May Term, 1818, Samuel Neil, William Cottle, John Hamilton...were the justices attending."

COTTLE, German (?). Charles William Cottle is the ancestor of the Nicholas
County Cottles. He came from Greenbrier to Nicholas, which was then Kanawha
County, about 1810. He purchased a tract of 800 acres of land in the glades,
still known as Cottle Glades. He soon had about 200 acres in meadow and engaged
in raising cattle. He is said to have sometimes wintered as many as 200
head of cattle. He was an influential citizen and was sheriff of Kanawha
County before the organization of Nicholas County. He took an active part
in the organization of Nicholas County. His name appears often in the early
records of the county.

Two of his sons, Uriah and William D. Cottle are named. The latter was one
of the justices named at the organization of the County.

The late William D. Cottle and John R. Cottle were grandsons of Charles
William Cottle. Some of their children and grandchildren live in the county.

Cottle post office and Cottle Knob are monuments to this pioneer family.

HUTCHINSON, Scotch-Irish. Jacob Hutchinson, ancestor of the family in
Nicholas, bought a tract of land in 1798, on Muddlety from John Wooden.
Jacob and his brother, William, came to the County from Greenbrier with
C. W. Cottle. (page 336)

KYER, KIRE, German. The Kyers were among the first settlers in Nicholas County.
They came with the Cottles, Cutlips and others from the South Branch of the
Potomac across the mountains and down Gauley River to the Glades along that
river. They are listed among the refugees that fled to Donnally's Fort in
Greenbrier at the time of the massacre of the Stroud family by the Indians.
John Kyer, Augustus Kyer, and Nicholas Kyer are among the first of the name
on our early records.

In 1855 W. D. Cottle conveyed to Charles W. Kyer a tract of 200 acres in the Cottle Glade locality.

Cottle B. Kyer, for many years a prominent teacher of the county, and James A. Kyer, a farmer and well known citizen, are lineal descendants of this pioneer family. (pages 345-6)

BRIEF HISTORY OF NICHOLAS COUNTY by J. M. Hutchinson - Transcribed and submitted by Brenda Collins Dillon Oct 1998 - Bj04@aol.com

This gives a partial account of some of the early settlers of Nicholas County, West Virginia. We can't be sure what settlements were made first outside of the Morris and Sims settlements. One thing we do know is that the killings of the Stroud family was before the Morris children were killed. On both occasions the citizens living in the Glades went to Donally's Fort in Greenbrier for safety. The Givens, Hamricks, Hannas, Cutlips, Gregor's Roses, McClures, and Doyles were families that carried their children and everything of value that they could.

William Hutchinson, a scotchman married Rebecca Warrack, a sister of Isaac Warrack. He died at Williamsport, Pennsylvania, a captain in the Revolutionary War. After his death his wife gave birth to triplets, Isaac, William, and Rebecca. Jacob Warrack, then of Clover Lick, raised the children.

David Hanna married Rebecca Hutchinson and came to the Glades. Soon after C. W. Cottle married Warrack's daughter and Jacob Hutchinson married Hanna McMillion. Both couples soon followed.

Hanna had bought 1,000 acres of land at the Welch Glades near the present site of Cowen. C. W. Cottle bought 1,000 acres near what is now Camden-on-Gauley. Hutchinson bought 500 acres on McMillion Creek, but of him we will speak later. Both of these other men did well, each one clearing over 200 acres of land and made other improvements and raised cattle and stock of all kinds. Both had large families that were well respected. Cottle was High Sheriff of Kanawha County and was one of the most influential men in the county. He, afterwards, represented Nicholas County in the Legislature. Both men were shrewd business men, but strange it is that both of these farms went delinquent and was sold for taxes from time to time until they passed into the hands of strangers, and family connections have almost disappeared. William and John Cottle on Phillips Run are great, great grandchildren of C. W. Cottle.

Jacob Hutchinson has been previously named. He and his brother came to this county with C. W. Cottle. William was a single man and a tanner by trade and lived with Cottle. He helped run the tannery until they had a dispute and Cottle whipped him and William left, going to Gallipolis, Ohio, where he married and had a large family.

1) Alvaro Dickinson Field writes that in 1838 Uriah Cottle was appointed to prepare a campground in Virginia (Settlement?). "The second quarterly meeting was held at Uriah Cottle's in Virginia Settlement 1/11/1840."

There was a meeting at David Duffield's 1/30/1841 where Uriah Cottle was present. On 6/28/1841, Uriah Cottle attended a Virginia meeting again. On 6/18/1842 there was a meeting held near Crystal Lake [state ... (is IL) near Marengo - because he previously notes that a class at Crystal Lake, IL in June 1837 had consisted of Albert Smith, leader; Asneath Smith, Samuel Smith, Polly Smith, Eunice Cobb, Orson P. Rogers, and Mary Rogers].

Alvaro also writes that The methodist minister Uriah Cottle was present at the first quarterly Methodist meeting at Round Prarie (11/4/1839). [L.S.Walker & Ora A. Walker also were preachers at that meeting].

2) From a handwritten few pages of genealogy of the Borton, Schieber, Mounsey, & Field families by Art Scheiber (written in about 1950's), Scheiber writes to Dorothy Mounsey Borton (whose great grandfather John Anderson Field died in the home of Mrs. L. M. Cottle in 1915 in St. Joseph, MI):

My Everdear Rachel:

I take my pen in hand this morning to drop you a few lines to let you know I am getting along. I am sorrow to tel you that I am not well. I was taken sick at Centerville {present day Greenville}.

I have had a bad head ache & pains in my shoulders and brest, but I have got better and am stil mending. I think I will be well in a day or too more. I received your last letter by James and red it with much interest. While I was glad to hear from you I was sorrow to hear that you had a sore throat; but I trust you are enjoying good health at this time. I would have come home when our scouts wint to the River, but I was on guard and could not get off. I tride to get some of the boys to take my place so I could go, but it was in vane. You can tel Vass that I look hard for him to come to see us while we was so close, but I did not see him. I watched the road daily while we staid in town.

Rachel, I will now try to comply with my promise but I

want you to understand that I so not want to disharte you in regard to my coming home. I have no other thought but that I will get home after while but I very well know that my life is in the hands of Providence. He alone can kill, and as life is uncertain I will tel you what I want you to do with what little property I have. If I should be caled off I want you to keep my cow and calf and the hogs and what is in the house. My part of the land I want you to have; but I want some of my people to tend the land for you. the motion of the widow of said dec'd who renounced the right to qualify as administratrix, Caperton Right was sworn as administrator and together with Andrew J. Lowe his security entered into & acknowledged his bond in the penalty of \$2000. with condition according to law, letters of administration in due form (together with the will annexed) of the estate of said Lewis W. Cottle dec'd. is granted him.

{Lewis William Cottle was a private in Co. F of the 26th Battalion Virginia Infantry, known as Edgar's Battalion. He was born in Monroe County Virginia about 1833, the third son of George W. & Ann Maria Lowe Cottle. He enlisted 8/20/1861 as a 4th Sgt. in Co. B, 166 Militia at Red Sulphur Springs. He enlisted in 26th Battalion Virginia Infantry on 4/29/1862 at White Sulphur Springs, Greenbrier County, WV. He was mortally wounded in the breast in action at White Sulphur Springs, WV, on 8/26 or 8/27/1863, known as the battle of White Sulphur Springs or Dry Creek. He died 9/17/1863 at White Sulphur Springs, WV. A postwar record says he was buried on the battlefield at White Sulphur Springs. Lewis William Cottle married Rachel Lowe, daughter of Alexander & Adaline Lowe, before the war. They had no children. Rachel Lowe Cottle died in the spring of 1872.}
