

1. **Hanna COTTLE** #2294, b. circa 1765/78, (daughter of **William Uriah COTTLE** #2159 and **Elizabeth ???** #2110). She married (2) 25 Jul 1836, **John FOSTER** #5650. Charged in Greenbrier court on 20 May 1793 with having a base born child. The 1810 Monroe Co. census lists her as between 26 and 45 with a daughter between 10 and 16, which means it must've been taken before her daughter's birthday because she would have had her 17th birthday that year based on the court date. Hannah Foster mentioned in John Cottle's 1850 will presumed to be a sister.

Children:

- i **?? COTTLE** #5678, b. circa 1793. Hannah (this child's mother) listed in 1810 Monroe County census as having a daughter between 10 and 16. Based on the court date she must have been born in early 1793 because she would have a 17th birthday that year and so would most likely be marked in the next higher category (16 to 26). Or else somebody just reported her younger than she was (her mom of course).
- ii **?? COTTLE** #8081, b. circa 1804/10. Male child listed in Hannah's household in 1820 census between 10 & 16.
